Since gaining planning permission in late August to demolish the workshop and replace with a modular building, grant applications have gone in to all seven local grant aiding organisations known to me, and delighted to report that we had a 100% success record. This has added £17,000 to our Fund which now stands at £87,000, just £16,000 short of our target of £103,000, so we are getting very close!
